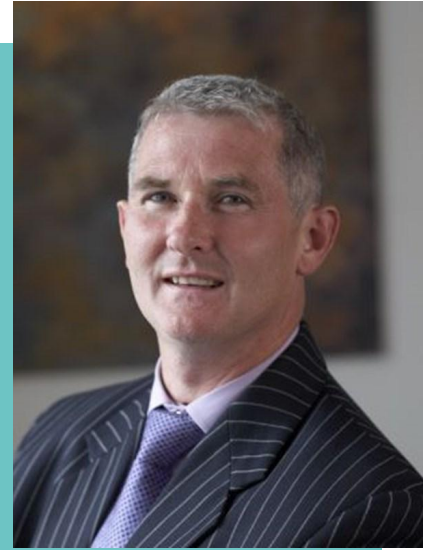
EDUCATION
